This form is for educational instructors seeking to offer public programs in Morris County that are related to litter abatement as per the Clean Communities Program. The Clean Communities Program was created as a statewide effort to reduce litter in our recreational and residential sites through education, cleanup, and enforcement activities. Public programs include presentations at libraries, schools, public camps, public fairs, etc. This form must be resubmitted on an annual basis to ensure our information stays updated.

The MCMUA will review each presenter and approve those that meet the Clean Communities criteria for educational presenters to hold in-person, public programs throughout Morris County. Upon approval, the MCMUA will notify you and add your program to a general list of programs and contact information for interested entities, with the goal of stimulating more awareness and interest in these programs. Submission of this form does not guarantee approval. All presenters must adhere to the policies and guidelines of the organization where the program is being delivered.

Please note that for this upcoming 2025-2026 grant period, Morris County will NOT be accepting funding requests directly from vendors. The organization hosting the presentation will be responsible for scheduling and funding your presentation and will be reimbursed directly by the MCMUA. Host organizations will be required to apply for this funding in advance.
