



**Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority
Municipal Recycling Coordinators Meeting
October 30, 2025**

Meeting Summary

The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority (MCMUA) hosted an in person Municipal Recycling Coordinator Meeting on October 30, 2025, at the Florham Park Municipal Complex. The meeting was held from 7:30 AM – 10:00 AM and there were 18 people in attendance, which included MRCs and CPWMs. The invitation to the meeting was extended to MRCs from other counties as some of the MRCs were from outside Morris County. The NJDEP requires all MRCs to attend one County-held meeting per year and 2 out of Morris County's 39 MRCs met this requirement by attending this meeting. The meeting was approved for 2.5 CRP Classroom Credits, 1.5 CPWM Government Credits, 1 CPWM Technical Credit, and 2.5 NJ Public Health Continuing Education Contact Hours.

Attendees arrived, signed in, and enjoyed coffee and breakfast sandwiches prior to the meeting start. Morris County's Recycling Coordinator, Anthony Marrone, welcomed everyone to the meeting. He reviewed the agenda and credits offered by this class and reminded everyone to sign in. The meeting could not be held at the planned location due to last minute cancellations, so it was instead hosted by the Florham Park DPW. The topics reviewed during the meeting included mandated recycling materials, acceptable materials in the MCMUA's curbside recycling program, recycling enforcement, food waste, and history of recycling in New Jersey. The meeting ended with Marrone announcing several planned trips and meetings in 2026 for municipal recycling coordinators.
