 - This includes both your residential & generator notification
- Attend a Class A Recycling Facility Tour in 2026**
 - Reach out to Michelle Chavanne at mchavanne@co.morris.nj.us for assistance
- Understand what materials your town should collect based on your hauler**
 - Does your hauler collect more than the county mandated materials?
 - Where does the hauler bring your materials to?
 - Do you have a depot and if so, what do they collect and who are the haulers?
- Compile a list of all generators in your town for next Tonnage Report**
- Create & share educational materials with residents & MCMUA**
- Register for the Certified Recycling Professional (CRP) course**
